## Prediction: Vice President Joe Biden's Debate Will Help President Obama Rebound

(AP) - Thursday's vice presidential debate has taken on even more significance after President Obama's performance in the Presidential debate last week against Republican candidate Mitt Romney.

The debate has caused the President to slide in polls that, across the board, have drastically swung in favor of the Republican ticket of Romney and Paul Ryan.

That puts a lot of pressure on Vice President Joe Biden to swing the momentum back to the Obama-Biden camp on Thursday, October 11, 2012, when he goes head-to-head in a debate with Ryan in Danville, Ky.

The debate is scheduled for Thursday, October 11, 2012, at 6PM PT/AT, 7PM MT, 8PM CT, and 9PM ET. The topic will be foreign and domestic policy.

### DALLAS BLACK CONTRACTORS DONATE SKILLED LABOR TO HELP ELDERLY WOMAN'S HOME MEET CITY CODE

This past week the Black Contractors Association of North Texas (BCA) partnered with the City of Dallas' People Helping People program to bring an elderly widow's home up to city code. Work started Thursday, October 4 and was completed Friday, October 5.

Since 1985, the People Helping People Program (PHP) has been assisting 62+ years of age or disabled homeowners with minor exterior home repairs. The goal is to eliminate code violations for seniors living on a fixed income.

The homeowner, who lives on Mystic Trail in the Highland Hills area of Dallas, suffers from health issues but her favorite past-time is sitting in her yard enjoying the breeze. However, extremely overgrown shrubs and trees have limited her view and access.

The volunteers who helped repair the home included landscapers, painters, general contractors, administrative professionals, and food sponsors.

(AP) - The number of babies born to teens and some women in their 20s hit new record lows in 2011, based on federal data released Wednesday. The numbers suggest the continuing decline in births could be more than just the lingering effect of recession.

(AP) - After spending years of his life sexually abusing boys entrusted into his care, and recent years denying it, Jerry Sandusky is likely to spend the rest of his life in jail. A judge sentenced the 68-year-old former Penn State assistant football coach Tuesday to at least 30 years in prison.

He had faced a maximum of 400 years for dozens of charges stemming from his sexual abuse of 10 boys over a 15-year period. Sandusky was convicted in June. After an emotional hearing in which victims detailed the horrors they endured and Sandusky still maintained his innocence.

### Green Cleaning Tip: Glass & Mirrors

Life gets busy with work, family and other commitments. We feel pulled first in one direction, then another. As parents, grandparents, aunts and uncles, however, we know that the first priority is always the children.

For caring parents and extended families, making sure that each child is prepared to meet the many challenges the future holds begins at the local school, where children are joined by dedicated and effective teachers, principals, other Dallas ISD staff and community volunteers who want the best for every child.

To stress the importance of education, many Dallas ISD parents volunteer at their children's schools, attend PTA meetings, organize fundraisers, and carry out countless other tasks that are welcome and appreciated by schools and the district. Not all parents can give of their time at that level, but ensuring their children understand how important education is to their future is the most important of all contributions.

Among several factors that support children's success in school, Dallas ISD asks parents to focus on doing three things:

- Make sure your children get to school on time, every day.
- Make sure your children do their homework.
- Make sure your children read at home every night.

These are the components of what the district calls the "ART of Success." Setting a routine so that, even when the parent is not at home, the children know when it's time for homework and that reading leads to success. Designating a small table or area for study also shows children how important learning is.

Another way parents can help their children be successful is by keeping in touch with the teacher. The Dallas ISD has several ways in which parents can do this, including the Parent Portal, which gives parents daily access to their child's grades, assignments, and attendance record. Ask your school how easy and useful Parent Portal can be.

Attending parent conferences, held at least twice a year, is another way parents can help their children succeed. The conferences give parents an opportunity to meet one-on-one with their child's teacher to discuss progress and ways in which learning can be reinforced at home. This fall's parent conferences will be held Oct. 15 for high schools, Oct. 16 for middle schools, and Oct. 18 for elementary schools.

Now, you also can keep up with your children's schools and receive instant news from your cell phone by downloading the just released Dallas ISD SchoolConnect app for Android and Apple devices at [www.dallasisd.org/mobileapp](http://www.dallasisd.org/mobileapp). The app offers access to the Parent Portal, lunch menus, calendars, school bus routes, and much more.

Flu season has arrived, along with many health organizations' reminders to consumers stop by a local pharmacy or even retail outlet to get your annual flu shot. But some

large employers are taking a much different approach and setting records in the process to keep their employees well and the flu bug at bay.

Mass, single-day inoc-

ulation drives are taking center stage this year. Last week, Kaiser Permanente set a new world record for the most flu shots given in a single day, administering 47,259 shots in an

eight-hour period. That's nearly four times the previous record (according to Guinness World Records) held by Vanderbilt University, which administered 12,851 shots.

In character, Psalm 24 can be classified as a Messianic psalm, depicting the arrival of the King of Glory, the Lord Jesus Christ. Many biblical scholars are in agreement that the occasion for this psalm was when David brought the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem (II Samuel Chapter 6). David begins this triumphant psalm by glorifying the name of God because He is the creator and owner of this vast earth. The earth and its fullness belong to Him. Our Lord is sovereign over everything - "The earth is the LORD's, and the fulness

thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein" (v. 1).

At the command of God on the third day of creation, He gathered together the waters and dry land appeared (Genesis 1:9-10). Our Sovereign God just spoke it and dry land appeared from the water. God is powerful, isn't He? God is the Creator and His creatures owe nothing but praise to Him. Knowing that He is the Creator, should evoke praise, for Psalm 146:1-2 says - "Praise ye the Lord, Praise the Lord, O my soul. One who is sincere in his worship and walks in integrity is a fit candidate. A worshipper whose conduct and character is holy can ascend into His presence. God is Holy and those who worship Him must be Holy (Leviticus 19:2). Worshippers who seek after the Lord will be blessed with righteousness (vs. 5-6).

In verses 7-10, because of the King's triumphant coming,

David calls for the ancient gates of Jerusalem to open wide to receive the triumphant King. This triumphant King is the Lord and He has been triumphant in battle. "Who is this King of glory?" Although the world does not know Him, believers of all ages know that the King is Jesus Christ, - "The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle" (v. 8). In His first advent, the world rejected Him; but during His second advent to the earth, Jesus Christ will descend to the earth and reign supremely as King of Kings and Lord of Lords (Revelations 19:11-16).

The next chapter in the fabled Red River Rivalry takes place at the Cotton Bowl in Dallas this Saturday, as the 15th-ranked Texas Longhorns square off against the 13th-ranked Oklahoma Sooners. ### Learns Valuable Lesson vs. Falcons

One of the knocks on Robert Griffin III before the 2012 NFL draft was that his build made him a liability when he ran the football.

That was on full display in Week 5 against the Atlanta Falcons when Griffin failed to get out of bounds in the third quarter and was tattooed by linebacker Sean Weatherspoon, suffering a concussion in the process. Head coach Mike Shanahan said
